CREATE YOUR OWN VLOG (Video Blog) ASSIGNMENT

Task: Create a brief (2-3 minute) VLOG that answers your topic question in a clear and engaging way.

Steps:

Step One: Conduct research on your topic question. Using the resources provided, take notes on key statistics, perspectives, and quotes that relate to this question.

Step Two: Plan your vlog. Complete the story map graphic organizer to plan your vlog. Be sure that all elements of your vlog come together to answer your topic question. Think about how you will use auditory and visual effects keep your viewers engaged and help them understand your topic.

Step Three: Film your vlog. You may use a simple device like a smart phone to film your vlog. Find a filming area with minimal background noise and good lighting. Be sure to rehearse before beginning to record. Remember to credit all sources at the end of your vlog.

Step Four: Share your vlog. Save your vlog in an easily shared file format or upload your file to Youtube.

How to Create an Effective Vlog:

- Begin by developing a strong understanding of your topic.
- Plan your vlog before filming so that it is cohesive and clear.
- Stay centered on one theme. Your vlog should not be longer than 2-3 minutes.
- Practice your vlog, paying attention to your eye contact, body language, and voice quality.
- Incorporate visuals and/or sound effects to keep your viewers engaged.
- Find a quiet area with good lighting to film your vlog.
- Think about using a video editor such as iMovie to add keywords to emphasize parts of your vlog.
